SCALE OF CHARGES

Effective 1st October 2025

Annual subscriptions are payable by the member institute directly to The Energy Consortium (TEC). This supports our legal position as a Contracting Authority and establishes the Institution as a Member of TEC.

Whilst the way that TEC commissions are calculated are similar in approach to those applied by many third parties, as TEC are a 'Not for Profit' organisation we cap commission to reflect the activity based costing needed to maintain our services and to not burden Members with unnecessary cost.

Having calculated the charges based on a p/kWh approach, the resultant charges are then collected on a pence per day basis as part of the standing charge made by the supplier. This way TEC will not benefit from increases in energy consumption where charges are applied on a p/kWh basis.

These charges will be applied and recalculated on a biannual basis throughout the life of the supply contract to ensure that, should you manage to reduce your consumption, we don't collect too much.

Collection on a pence per day basis and biannual reviews ensure that our charges are fair and transparent at all times. Commissions are payable via the supplier per institution per contract per annum; these payments are made directly by the framework supplier to TEC and its back office Risk Management Support Services provider, as applicable.

Commissions are rounded down from the values given, to enable compatibility with energy billing structures.

TEC MEMBERSHIP - Payable per Institution pa

- £750** Total Energy Usage greater than 40,000,000 kWh
- £500** Total Energy Usage between 10 - 40,000,000 kWh
- £250** Total Energy Usage up to 10,000,000 kWh
- £500** Water Framework only Members

WATER FRAMEWORK - Payable per Institution pa

- 0.5%** Of total Water and Wastewater Annual Charges
- 1%** For Water Framework ancillary services

UK-ETS ADMINISTRATION SUPPORT SERVICE

MEMBER SPECIFIC CHARGES - Charges to be issued each April once received from the verifier.

DISCONNECTED / TRANSFERRED METERS

Meters which are disconnected/transferred during the contract under change of ownership of the member premises served by the meter will have the associated commission removed by the supplier for the remaining term of the contract from the date of change of ownership or meter disconnection.

POST COMPETITION ADDITIONS (New Meters or New Connections) – Application of Commission

In order to recognise the work involved in adding new meters to the portfolio either after the start of a flexible contract period or following the award of a contract via a further competition, the following charges will apply:

ELECTRICITY CONTRACTS

- Non-Half Hourly Supplies **£24 per meter pa**
- Half Hourly Supplies **£240 per meter pa**

GAS CONTRACTS*

- Supply AQ < 10,000 therms (293,070 kWh) **£24 per meter pa**
- Supply AQ > 10,000 therms (293,071 kWh) **£240 per meter pa**

*Charges will be accrued and applied on a per-day basis and will form part of the supplier standing charge. These charges will be applicable whether the addition is an existing supply or new connection.

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
